A big **THANK YOU** to those who supported our recent Dinner at BCOT. Between us we raised a significant £1150! As part of the evening we had a raffle (well, you have to don't you?) We had some super prizes this year from Slater's Menswear, Newbury Building Society, Festival Place, Waterstones, The Entertainer and Mobile Phone Bitz. So if you are able to support them it would be a great way of saying 'Thank you'.

I'm also pleased to report that a local charity 'Four Lanes Trust' have awarded us a grant of £500 to update our publicity materials. We will be buying some smart new banners, table cloths and printing some new leaflets. This will be extremely useful when we are out on our awareness days as we will be much more visible. **Remember**, your Shopmobility Basingstoke registration covers you for 12 other local schemes under the Wessex Network (Andover, Castlepoint, Chichester & Havant, Eastleigh, Fareham, Newport – Isle of Wight, Portsmouth, Salisbury, Southampton City, West Quay and Winchester). You will have to give your details to them as our computers are not linked but you will not need to pay their registration fee, just their daily hire fee. Your re-registration is paid at your 'home scheme', this is defined as the scheme in your home town or the one you use most. Do we do our best to make sure you enjoy you Shopmobility experience? If the answer to any of the above is 'no' then please speak to me (Anne) or Lin as a matter of urgency so that we can improve our service.



As I am writing this, our grant from **Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council** has yet to be confirmed. Although the recommendation has gone to Cabinet that we should receive the same amount (which is in itself 15% down from previously) it is always a bit nerve wracking until it is confirmed. Even with this grant and the

income from customer charges we are still £20,000 short each year which is why we have such an active fundraising calendar. Recent successes are: Christmas **Gift Wrapping** in Festival Place, **BCOT Dinner**, sale of **donations of scooters/wheelchairs**, our **100 Club**, sale of **Easter Chicks**, **Race Night**, **Quiz Nights**, **Coin Boxes** at home, sale of clothes and Bric-a-Brac in the office and sales on **Ebay**. We have also been the recipients of the collection held at the funeral of a customer who had passed away!



Are *you*, your family or friends able to support any fundraising initiatives so that we can maintain the customer charges at their current level? Easy choices are: **The 100 Club** – Shopmobility's very own lottery. Pay in £2 per month, £1 goes into the prize fund and £1 to maintain the service. Currently the prize fund

stands at £160 per month divided into 4 prizes increasing as more numbers are sold.

Coin Box at Home – A collection box that you can have at home to put you loose change into. Some customers ask friends to make a donation when they come for tea/coffee. Monies collected this way go purely towards buying new scooters/wheelchairs.

**Friends Club** – A new initiative! Pay £10 per year to become a 'Friend'. Receive a free badge/key-ring, Friends Newsletter and priority booking for events. Monies go directly towards the purchase of new scooters/wheelchairs.

**Bag Collection** – Donate unwanted clothes, shoes, bags and belts and we can sell them by weight. Next collection 9am **Thursday May 7<sup>th</sup>**. Ask for a bag in the office or use any bin/carrier bag.

Or maybe you would prefer to attend something and have some fun while helping us to raise vital funds. Would you like to come to:

A Quiz Night – Friday May 8<sup>th</sup>, Church Cottage (behind St Michael's Church), 7.30pm start £5pp tea/coffee provided, bring your own food. Max of 6 per team

**Lunch at BCoT** – Wednesday June 10<sup>th</sup> £14.50 for a 2 course lunch with tea/coffee. Organised especially for those of you who wanted to come to the dinner but find it difficult to get out, can't eat 3 courses etc we have organised a lunch. Speak to Anne or Lin for more information. **A Race Night** – Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> October. (Town centre venue to be confirmed.) This is a fun evening betting (£1 per race only) on filmed races with a buffet supper. £15pp.



**Sunday Opening** — Although we are not open on Sundays, we are able to leave **pre-booked equipment** for **registered customers** at Festival Place to be collected from the information desk outside Marks and Spencer's. You will need to make the booking by 1pm on Saturday to enable us to get it to Festival Place for you.

We will be operating our popular 'On Tour' service again this summer, taking equipment to The Transport Festival on 10<sup>th</sup> May 10am-5pm, Alton Agricultural Show on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July 9am-5pm and Alresford Agricultural Show on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> September 9am-5pm Equipment will need to be booked in advance as we are limited as to how much equipment we can take to each event. Normal charges apply at the Transport Festival but as the Agricultural shows are outside of our area the charge is a flat 'show rate' of £12. If you would you like an outing a bit closer to home then why not join one of our '**Trundles**'? Take one of our scooters/power chairs on an organised jaunt around Basingstoke accompanied by Shopmo staff. Make new friends and enjoy doing something different. Groups are kept to a maximum of 8 for maximum enjoyment. They are popular so make the decision and book. If they are oversubscribed we may be able to

increase the dates. Currently we are going to:

Leave Shopmobility 2p.m. return approx 4.30p.m. scooter/power chair and refreshments £7.50TBC **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> July** – Basingstoke Parks followed by tea/coffee & cake at Shopmobility. Leave Shopmobility at 2p.m. returning at 3.30p.m. for refreshments. £5 Friends/family are welcome to join us they can either do our training and take a scooter/power chair or walk. **Do you like going to the theatre?** Would it be easier if there was a wheelchair waiting there for you? With a little bit of organising we can leave one there for you to use. Leave it there and we will pick it up the next day and return it to the office.





There has been lots of change within the National Federation of Shopmobility (NFSUK). We are now proud to be part of a much bigger organisation the British Healthcare Trading Association (BHTA). We have to adhere to their extremely robust code of

practise so you can have extra confidence in our customer care and systems of operation.

We are also ticket agents for **Morton's Coaches**. They have a very varied list of day trips available with pick up points around Basingstoke and Tadley. Pick up a brochure from the office. They will take wheelchairs, walkers and travel scooters as long as you or someone with you can put them in the baggage hold.

Due to our **successful fundraising and the sale of donated equipment** we have been able to update our fleet.

We now have 2 x 4 wheeled walking frames, a child's wheelchair and 3 new 3-wheeled scooters. The walking frame has a more modern design, is lighter in weight and folds more easily and neater than the traditional four-wheeled walking frames. The front wheels swivel, making it very manoeuvrable and the seat is quite comfortable if you want to sit and take the weight off your feet. If you don't always need a scooter but feel a bit unsteady with just a stick, or maybe you can't take a scooter away with you, then maybe you would find one of these useful. Charges £1.50 per day (+£100 deposit if taking it home/away). The '3 wheeled scooters' actually have 2 wheels in the front close together instead of 1, making them even more stable than the current 'Toms'. If you haven't used one yet ask to try one. One customer said 'That was the smoothest scooter I've ridden since 1986!'
